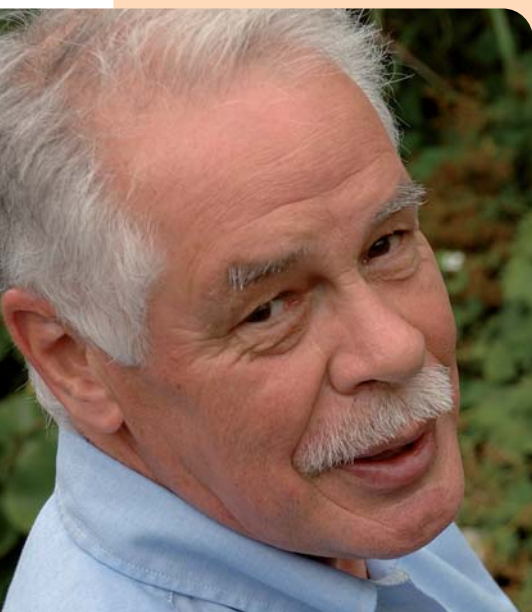
Tax return assistance
